

Rolling Green Town Board Minutes

July 11, 2016

Members present – Dan, Brian, David, Daniel, Todd.

Beginning Balance - \$103,880.87 - Checking \$1275.26 - Savings \$102,605.61

Deposit this month – \$175.48 interest, \$85,154.34 June settlement = \$85,329.82 total

Paid this month - \$3735.64 + \$3000 to FFMR

Ending Balance - \$182,475.05 - Checking \$4693.96 - Savings \$177,781.09

Other Asset accounts - \$27,000 - FFMR \$7,000.00, Grader CD \$20,000

Brian recently met with Bill Crawford regarding a new hog site for Ken Klug on the 40 across the road from Trevor Eisenmingers. It probably won't be constructed until next year.\

Krahmer is not building his latest planned hog site at this time, but is only getting all the paperwork in order.

Brian and Dan met with the other United Township representatives on the team meeting with Fairmont. A proposal was put together to be presented to Fairmont at the meeting this coming Friday. The proposal is to up the hourly rate from \$15 to \$30 per hour and to keep the truck ownership and maintenance the same as it currently is.

Dan talked with the Photo Press. An Ad will be placed in the appropriate issue stating ditches must be mowed by October 15, with trees, rocks, etc removed. If this is not done, the township can do this and charge the owner, or place it on their taxes.

The Welcome Fire Meeting is scheduled for Monday, August 22, 6 PM at the Fire Hall.

An e-mail was received from Troy Nemmers regarding the old lime pits by the tree dump road. The City of Fairmont is planning to close them and needs to do some regarding for water flow affecting the township ditch. Our board sees no problems at this time with the plans and Dan will reply to Troy with the go ahead.

An e-mail was received from Kevin Peyman stating he has state money available to replace the collapsing culvert on the tree dump road yet this fall. The township cost would be about \$10,000, payable after completion of the project sometime in 2017. The board gave the go ahead and Dan will let Kevin know.

Dan Whitman sent an e-mail regarding the new procedure to receive Board of Equalization training. It is now available as internet training. At this time, it was decided to continue with the county procedure we have done the last few years. If a problem arises, a supervisor could take the training and the BOE process returned to the township.

As our fund balance seems to be in good shape, it was decided to move \$20,000 to the grader CD fund.
