April 10, 2017

The minutes were approved as presented.

The financials were reviewed.

David moved, seconded by Brian, to pay the bills.

A notice was received that the windmill tax for the REA tower will be \$512.50 for 2017.

A work permit has been received from Paul Hein to place a tile under 150th Ave south of 130th Street. David moved, seconded by Daniel, to approve the permit.

Jesse Murphy picked up an application for a work permit to install a driveway. Daniel and Brian will follow up on this.

The ITC power line project is winding down. They need to remove all the rock from their construction site. It will be available for the cost of hauling. This needs to be followed up on.

Dan and John Garbers will be meeting with the Welcome Fire Department on Wednesday to discuss options for coverage in the United Township area.

Dan reviewed what happened at the Fairmont Council work session regarding the fire agreement with United Townships Fire Association. This consisted of Mr. Humple presenting his position to the council with very little feedback from the council. Dan Whitman and Randy Musser have taken a closer look at his figures and there appears to be some major discrepancy in his numbers.

Dan attended a meeting regarding the windmill projects being proposed west and east of here. Options were discussed to protect the roads structure in the townships.

Dan ??? complained of the snow plow cutting a ridge of grass and leaving it in the ditch where he mows. Unless it is exceptionally large, we want to be careful about getting involved with cleaning this type of thing up.
