

# Rolling Green Town Board Minutes

## January 8, 2018

Members present – Dan, Todd, Daniel, Brian, David

Beginning Balance - \$29,829.61 - Checking \$1225.47 - Savings \$28,604.14

Deposit this month – \$4545.84 plus \$68.81 interest plus \$59,781.66 made before last month's meeting

Paid this month - \$3753.46

Ending Balance - \$90,472.46 - Checking \$6799.51 - Savings \$83,672.95

Other Asset accounts - \$70,000 - FFMR \$10,000.00, Grader CD \$60,000

Both monthly financials and year-end 2017 financials were presented to the board.

Brian talked to county engineer Keven Pyman about the culverts/bridge on 150<sup>th</sup> Ave. It currently contains a 6 ft culvert and a 4 foot culvert with about 4 feet between them. State requirements only add culverts together if the distance between them is less than half the diameter of the smaller culvert, so currently, they are considered two separate culverts, not one 10 foot culvert. If they were closer together they would qualify as a bridge as 10 feet qualifies for state funding as a bridge.

What are our options?

If we do a full replacement at this time, we would need to pay all expenses, including engineering costs to design the replacement bridge.

We could repair/reinforce the larger culvert as it is not in really bad shape. A smaller culvert could be placed next to the large one. These changes would qualify the structure as a bridge sometime in the future. The county will come out and meet with us to discuss our options. It was decided to explore this option further next spring with the thought of doing the project this coming summer.

Dan has set up direct deposit with the county.

There is a drainage conference coming up if anyone is interested.

Both Dan & Daniel paid their \$2.00 filing fees to run for reelection for their respective offices.
