October 8, 2018

Daniel reported there is a FEMA meeting this Wednesday, 10/10 from 2-5pm. This meeting will start the application process for the flooding that occurred earlier this year. Daniel will plan to attend this and get the process going.

It was decided to pay Charles Armburst \$150 in tractor rental for his help in clearing off Pierce Lake Road following the recent wind storm.

Brian received a call from Jim Rosburg saying he is having trouble getting up the road. He mentioned spots by Olson's, the Krahmer hog site, and the south end by Becker's. None of the board is aware if anything worse than other gravel roads. Brian and Daniel will check out these areas and see if additional gravel is needed.

Brian discovered the road by the Ken Klug barn construction site was in bad shape and the culvert under the driveway did not appear to be working. Romsdahl construction is doing the work. Brian will follow up with this and see if the contractor needs to return the road to its previous condition.

Elections are November 6. Township polls are open from 10 am to 8 pm. Daniel, Brian, Todd and Dan will plan to act as election judges. If they are busy each will try to find a replacement. 3 judges are needed at all times during the day. Dan acting as head judge can open the polls, be on call during the day if an issue arises, then return to help close the polls.

Daniel moved, seconded by David, to pay the bills. Motion carried
