## July 9, 2018

Beginning Balance - \$71,890.46 - Checking \$662.39 - Savings \$71,228.07

The Apple tree by Milt Smith's on 140<sup>th</sup> Ave

Pierce Lake Road

The culvert on 140<sup>th</sup> Ave north of the corner with 80<sup>th</sup> Street will be replaced by Brian.

Additional gravel needs to be placed in washouts on shoulders.

Daniel moved, seconded by David, to pay the bills. Motion carried.
